**Peter W. Henderson, MD**

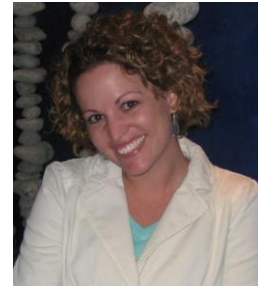
